

Notes from the Nurses Office

The health and well-being of our Prout School community is very important to us. We want to provide the optimum school experience for our students. **The Nurses Office uses the Magnus Electronic Health Record linked: <https://secure.magnushealthportal.com/>**

Parents/guardians will be sent a link to set up a password during the summer to manage and access your account, enter your child's health information and upload documents. There is also a mobile app for your convenience. Please check your spam folder if you cannot find this email.

1. The **Student Health Questionnaire** and **Vital Health Record** are required for all students and only need to be completed once and updated as necessary..
2. The **RI School Physical Form including immunizations** is required for all newly enrolled students. Physicals must be dated within 12 months of the start of school. Upload to Magnus.
 - In accordance with state regulations, TPS students trying out for an athletic team are required to have an annual physical and submit the RIIIL Pre participation physical evaluation prior to participation in any sport. This form is in addition to the RI School physical form. Please contact Athletics for more information.
3. Any student with allergies, asthma, a seizure disorder, and/or diabetes must complete an **Action Plan with a physician's signature** for every school year which expire at the end of the school year. Upload to Magnus.
4. The Over-The-Counter (OTC) and Prescription Medication Consent Forms. As per school policy, all medications require a physician authorization/signature and parent authorization to be dispensed at school. The forms must be submitted each school year and expire at the end of the school year. Prescription medications include inhalers and EpiPens. All forms can be printed from the school web site and uploaded to the Magnus Electronic Health Record. Bring all medication in the pharmacy-labeled package to the school. All medications must be carried into the school by an adult and given to the nurse.

-The school wide Flu Shot Clinic will take place in Fall 2022, exact date TBD.. Online registration will be available in September.

-The state mandated vision & dental screening will be scheduled for Grade 9 students in the fall. Parental/Guardian permission is not required for the stated mandated screenings. We will accept a physician's signature and parent/guardian note to decline these screenings.
