

**The Prout School Theatre program presents *Macbeth* by William Shakespeare on February 10 and February 11 at 7:30pm.** The performance will be presented by students, alumni, faculty and administration, as well as guest artists.

Movement and dance are being added to *Macbeth* to enhance the subtext or subconscious of the characters in the play. While actors are being used; dance and movement are interwoven to create a multi-dimensional and innovative take on this Shakespeare classic. Guest dancers include professionals; Nicholas Real of Clubwest Dance Studio, Shane Farrell and Christine Sandorfi of Island Moving Company and Elizabeth Stackhouse of Spindle City Ballet.

The dance/movement will be performed in such styles as ballroom, ariel ballet, contemporary and ballet styles to entice the audience-- adding ambience and mystique to this production.
