

NEW STUDENT AND INTERNATIONAL REGISTRATION

GRADES 9-12

Required Health Information

Below is the official health information required for every student entering Grades 9-12 at The Prout School. To begin school, students need documentation of the following signed and dated by a physician:

Physical Examination:

- A copy of your child's most recent physical examination. **(MUST be signed and dated by a physician within 12 months of start of school and translated into English if applicable).**

Immunization Requirements for All Students Entering Prout:

- One (1) dose of Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis) within last 10 (ten) years
- Four (4) doses of Polio vaccine—one (1) dose administered after age 4
- Two (2) doses MMR vaccine (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
- Three (3) doses Hepatitis B vaccine
- Two (2) doses Varicella (chickenpox) vaccine OR a statement signed by your child's doctor stating dd/mm/yyyy of your child's chickenpox disease
- One (1) dose of Meningococcal conjugate (MCV4) vaccine
- Two –three (2-3) doses HPV (Human Papillomavirus) vaccine OR a Religious Exemption

- International Students require a negative TB serum interferon test done in the United States. The Prout School Nurse will arrange this test.
